1	Welcome and Introductions

	As per slides 4 and 5, Victor Moreno (VM), Deputy Site Manager, gave an update on works completed since the last NESS Community Group meeting in October 2022. He advised on work in progress and plans for the coming 6 months. He advised that out of hours working and night shifts will continue until 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2023.			

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3	Complaints		
	During the period since the last meeting, Acciona had been made aware of five complaints.		
	Parking remains the main issue. Staff and subcontractors are regularly reminded of the need to park courteously and each of the incidents was dealt with.		
	There had been an incident in December regarding the treatment of two traffic wardens in Greenbank Road, believed to be from workers on the project and subcontractors were advised of the incident and the need to treat people courteously and with respect.

	No contacts from the public were received during the period, and Acciona sent out two notifications; one regarding a road closure, and the other regarding the extension to the night shift hours.
